So Jamie does what she always does. She skips the tech

This is not a skills problem.

**This is a **systems problem.****

*But that's not the question that matters in moments like this.*

*At the same time, she's holding everything else.*

*What could this be?*

*What can't I miss?*

*When do I escalate?*



# She scribbles a few words.

*A time.*

*A reminder.*

*Just enough not to forget.*

## Those scribbles aren't *laziness*.

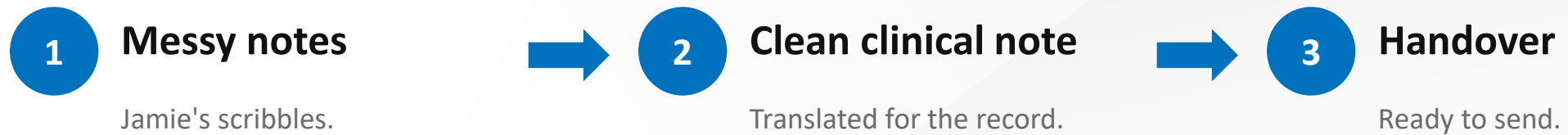
## They're **survival**.

*Jamie isn't overwhelmed because the care is hard.*

*She's overwhelmed because everything is hard at the same time.*



# Copilot = “Tomorrow Me”



*Tomorrow morning. Jamie opens her laptop.*

R lower leg again?? known pt, DM2, HTN



**Nothing about the care was changed.**

Judgement stayed with **Jamie**.

She just didn't have to translate herself anymore.

*That alone is real relief.*



*But it's still tomorrow.*

Jamie doesn't forget because she's careless.

She forgets because she's tired. Because she's interrupted.

Because she's human.

**So what if the scribble itself  
was enough?**



# The system works around the **night**.

## INPUTS

- Fragments.
- Voice notes.
- Natural traces.



## OUTPUT

**Assembled context.**  
**Timeline.**  
**Clinical note.**  
**Handover.**



# Notice what **didn't** happen.

She didn't stop  
to look things up.

She didn't break  
clinical flow.

She didn't learn  
a new system.

Nothing got lost.

*The system worked around her — not the other way around.*



The patient is stable.

Jamie is exhausted.

# Jamie goes to sleep...

*...without replaying the night in her head.*

---

Because the record already exists.



# So — what got easier?

*Not the care. The care was never meant to be easy.*

*What got easier was everything around it.*

**Finding context.**

**Remembering.**

**Documenting.**

**Explaining.**

**Being on call.**

**Recovering.**



The breakthrough isn't that AI can write documents.

**It's that the way clinicians already work  
finally counts.**



# Two futures.

*More will be asked of clinicians. The question is how that weight gets carried.*

## ONE FUTURE

More systems.

More forms.

More pressure to remember,  
rewrite, and justify.

## ANOTHER FUTURE

Same accountability —  
**less friction.**

Same standards —  
**less personal cost.**
